The project, which provides housing for low income, disabled and homeless seniors, is named in honor of Barton Harvey III, who had a career dedicated to the creation of affordable housing and rebuilding communities. LIHI is delighted to have this opportunity to honor Mr. Harvey and his work. Mr. Harvey himself is scheduled to speak at the celebration, as are Seattle Mayor Greg Nickels, former Seattle mayor Norman Rice, Seattle City Council President Richard Conlin and LIHI Executive Director Sharon Lee.

The 6-story building features 5 floors of studio apartments and 1-bedroom units. The ground floor will feature a library room with a computer lab, community meeting space, and offices for case management and support services. The building is constructed to a strict environmental standard and includes a green, vegetated rooftop which uses sustainable technology to cover surfaces with lightweight soil, allowing residents to plant everything from vegetable gardens to wildflowers.

Seniors making up to 50% of the Area Median Income are eligible to live at The Bart Harvey. The residents will pay no more than 30% of their income in rent. 10 of the units are set aside for previously homeless seniors. Another 10 units are set aside for disabled seniors.
